Thank you for your interest in Acres of Adventure Summer Camp at Ann & Andy's.

We care for children from the ages of two months through fourteen years old. For the children finishing Kindergarten through Fourth grade, we offer a developmentally appropriate summer program which has been designed for them. Children eleven years old (finishing fifth grade) through fourteen years old participate in our Tween Travel Program called Away We Go.

Enclosed you will find a summer enrollment form with a rate schedule and a brief overview of the many activities Acres of Adventure at Ann & Andy's has planned for your child during the summer.

Please complete and return the enclosed form with payment. The summer session is scheduled based and what you reserve on this form is what you will be responsible for. These forms are needed on time to register for the Summer Session. All fees, including tuition, registration fees (if applicable) and food, must be prepaid before the first day of camp as stated on the enrollment form or it will delay the start of camp for your child.

A medical form is needed for each child registered in our summer camp. This is due by June 13th. We will accept a copy of your child's school medical providing it has a list of immunizations, with a doctor's signature and is dated within the last year. Your child may not start camp without this form on file.

WELCOME TO A SUMMER OF FUN

Our summer is a time for fun and outdoor games. At Acres of Adventure Summer Camp at Ann & Andy's we get away from our classroom atmosphere and take on a camp routine. We will be spending time with old friends and meeting new friends. Many of the same counselors will be returning and our new counselors will bring with them new energy and ideas.

Our Summer Session starts on Monday, June 27th and ends on Friday, August 26th. Our hours of operation are 7:00 am – 6:00 pm. We are looking forward to seeing everyone.

Beginning Tuesday, July 5th and continuing through Thursday, August 11th, we will be going swimming at Rocky Ledge Swimming Pool in White Plains.

For children in the 3/4's (2018 births), they will go to the pool on Monday & Thursday mornings.

For children in the 4/5's (2017 births), they will go to the pool on Monday, Wednesday & Thursday mornings.

All children in the outside groups, who finished Kindergarten through Fourth grade, will go Monday through Thursday mornings. We leave at 9am everyday.

Instructional swim classes will meet daily when we are at the pool. Group sizes will be four students, of the same ability, to one swim instructor. The class will be thirty minutes in length. Campers (births years 2017-2012) must sign up in advance and the cost is \$7 per session. You can choose one, two, or three times per week for up to five weeks from July 11th through August 11th. Please check the appropriate spot on the registration form for the amount of lessons per week you would like for your child(ren) and include that amount with your tuition payments. There will be no refunds/makeups for missed swim lessons due to weather or absence.

Free swim is well supervised with two lifeguards. All of our staff is also in the pool and at the pool deck. The children are bused to and from the pool, except on rainy days, so please call if there is any doubt as to whether or not we are going and ALWAYS send them in their bathing suits as the weather changes quickly. The bus is provided with seat belts.

Beginning July 5th, the children (birth date 2018 and older) will be bused to the bowling alley at Homefield Bowl weekly for some more fun. The children really enjoy this summer activity. The bowling alley is air- conditioned and we go rain or shine. The bowling alley is following all CDC & DOH guidelines. They installed a new air filtration system last year and sanitize the balls and lanes before we arrive.

The outside campers (2016-2012 births) will go Monday afternoons (1:15pm-3:45pm). The 3/4's (2018 births) and 4/5's (2017 births) will go Tuesday mornings (9:45am-11:45am).

ALL CHILDREN MUST WEAR MASKS AND RUBBER-SOLED SHOES TO THE BOWLING ALLEY.

Ice cream truck (2019-2012 births) & snack bar (Outside campers 2016-2012 births) is paid in advance with registration. The ice cream truck comes every Thursday afternoon. The cost is \$4. The snack bar is every Tuesday from July 5th - August 9th. It's \$3 a week and the children can buy a snack while at the pool.

In addition to these off-campus activities, children will enjoy arts & crafts, computer lab, playing soccer, baseball, track, dodge ball, flag football, relay races, volleyball, basketball, tetherball, bicycle riding, zip line, archery, climbing wall and other field games on campus. Of course, the 2 (two) water slides will also be an enjoyable activity for children of all ages!

In addition to all of the above activities, the children will be engaging in nature and science walks, ice cream sundae party, BBQ Fridays and much more.

We will have a theater performance coming to us again this year to put on a show on Friday, July 15 @ 10:30 with a rain date of Tuesday, July 26 @ 1:30.

Much of your child's day will be spent outside so please apply the first application of sunscreen at home and we will reapply again in the afternoon. All campers will be required to wear bathing suits everyday (even if the weather looks questionable) and bring in a child sized camp bag (appropriate for your child to carry themselves) with the following items in it:

- Towel
- Sunscreen (as well as a permission slip for us to re-apply midday)
- Change of clothes
- Plastic bag (for wet/dry clothes)
- A 2nd bathing suit

ALL ITEMS MUST BE LABELLED!! For the older children, they will be doing most of their own changing at camp with assistance where needed. If their things are labeled, it will decrease the lost and misplaced items. Your help in this matter would be greatly appreciated.

Children must wear sneakers because they do a lot of climbing. Those who wish may send pool shoes in their child's camp bag. All food brought from home must be in a lunch box and clearly labeled. For the outside campers, lunch boxes will be kept in a cooler under the tent. For inside campers, they will be kept on a shelf in their classroom. There is NO refrigeration or heating available.

NO NUT PRODUCTS. This will be strictly enforced and your child will be given school food to supplement and your account will be charged the appropriate fee.

A medical form is needed for each child registered in our summer camp. This is due no later than Monday, June 13th. We will accept a copy of your child's school medical providing it has a list of immunizations, with a doctor's signature and is dated within the last year. Your child may not start camp without this form on file.

As a courtesy and for bus departures, please notify camp of any absences by 8:15 am that day, the day before, leave a message on our answering machine or send an email. You will still be monetarily responsible for the day, but we need to know for trips, specials and most importantly to know that your child is safe and healthy.

Tipping your child's counselor at the end of their camp experience, for a job well done, is recommended and greatly appreciated. Customarily, it is suggested to give \$1.50 for each day that your child attends to their head counselors and co-counselors. For CIT's (counselors in training) approximately \$0.75 a day is appropriate.

- There is a minimum of two (2) days per week for three weeks for the summer session. If your child (ren) will be attending less than three weeks, the charge will be the daily rate plus 20%.
- Program changes prior to the start of camp are subject to availability and must be submitted in writing to the office.
- These rates include all weekly specials (i.e., pool, bowling, and transportation to these programs)
- The two week notification of termination requirement as stated on the registration forms for year round children, does not apply to the summer session.
- The sibling discount is 5% off the flat rate for each sibling.
- Payment schedule

- * Pre-payment of \$400.00 per child is due by **Friday, February 11, 2022**. (Plus, registration fee for new students)
- * First payment of ½ of the summer tuition, including food, additional trips and swim lessons, is due by **Friday, April 18, 2022**.
- * Second payment of the remaining ½ of the summer tuition, including food, additional trips and swim lessons, is due by **Friday, June 17, 2022**. (This is minus the pre-payment fee of \$400.00)
- * All fees, including tuition, registration fees (if applicable), extra trips, swim lessons and food, must be prepaid before the first day of camp as stated on the enrollment form or it will delay the start of camp for your child, NO EXCEPTIONS!

THESE PAYMENTS ARE NON-REFUNDABLE

- Payment method – We accept cash, Zelle, checks and credit cards with a convenience fee of 3 ½%
- Registration Fees – For **NEW** students the registration fee is \$100.00. For additional siblings applying at the same time, there will be a \$25.00 registration charge.
- THESE FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.**
- Vacation and Sick Days – **Any vacation days/weeks must be blocked out by Friday, April 15, 2022. After this date there will be NO more changes allowed to your child’s summer schedule. You will be responsible for and charged for all scheduled days and weeks you have reserved. THERE ARE NO SICK/VACATION DAYS DURING THE SUMMER SESSION. You will be charged for the time absent during your reserved weeks/days.**
- Any payment not received on time, according to the payment schedule above, will be subject to a \$25 per week per child late fee.

By signing below, I give permission for my child/children to go on all trips and/or activities off campus, including but not limited to swimming, bowling, etc with authorized staff members of DCA/Ann & Andy Child Care Center.
